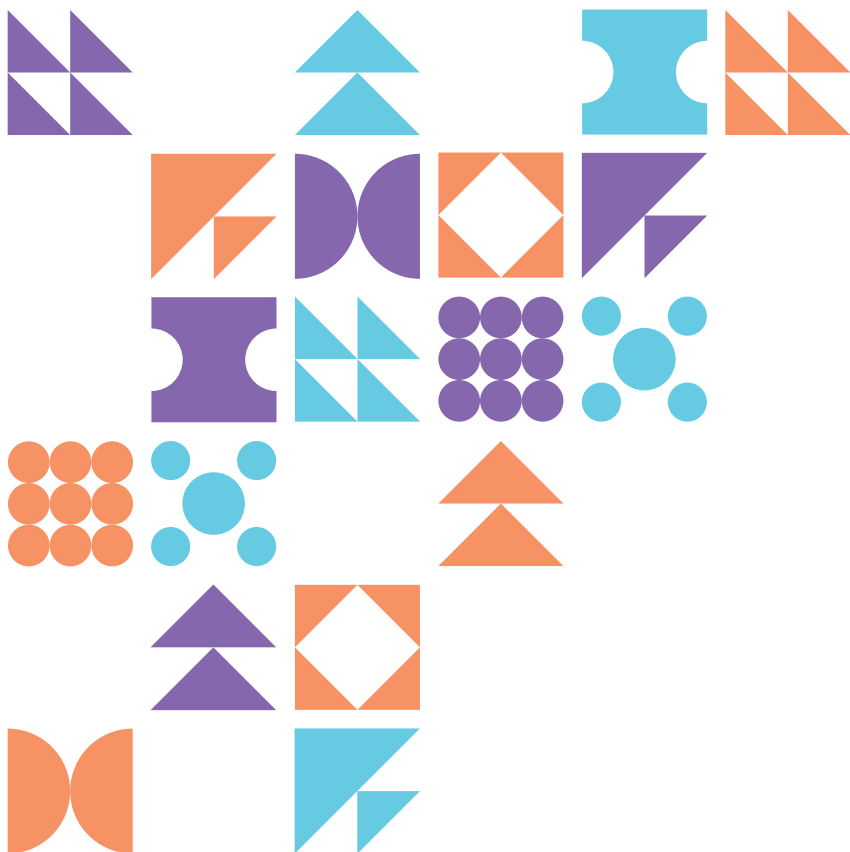


The Vital Role of Critical Thinking in Businesses and the Workplaces

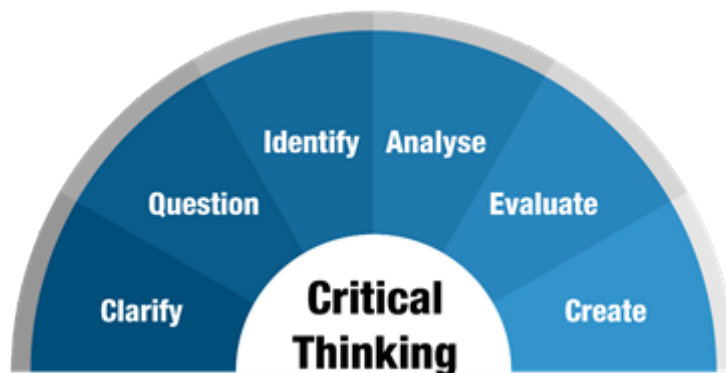
Practical Applications in Business:

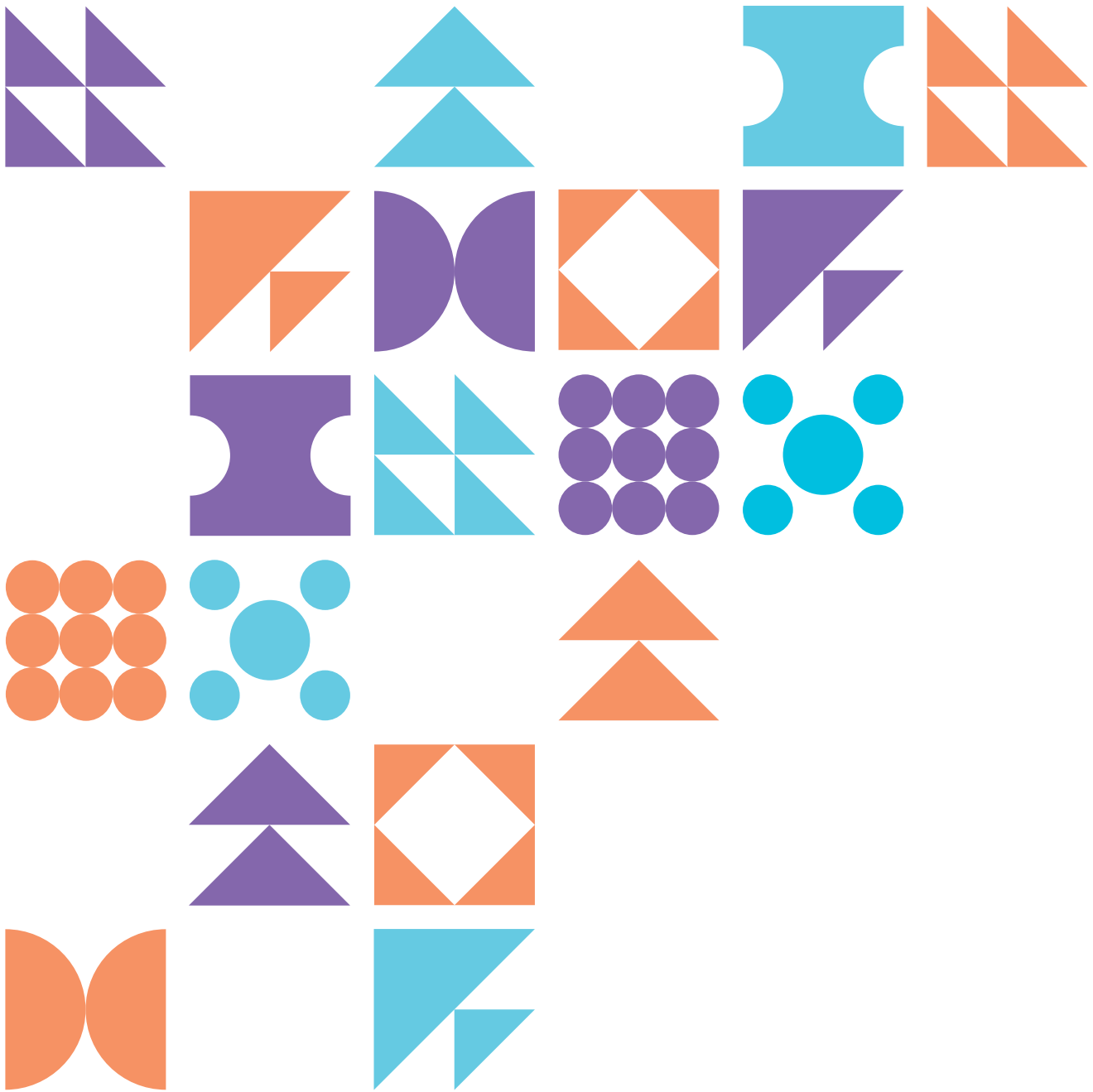
